II. Exposition: His Final Week – Wednesday (Mark 14:1-11)

- A. The <u>Plot</u> by the Priests (14:1-2)
 - 1. The <u>Passover</u> was two days off
 - 2. The *priests* seek to seize Him by stealth
 - 3. *"The people may riot" feared the priests*
- B. The <u>Pouring</u> of Costly Perfume (14:3-9)
 - 1. <u>While</u> He was at Bethany
 - At the home ...
 - At the table ...
 - 2. <u>Woman</u> breaks vial and pours costly perfume
 - Pure nard
 - Poured on Head
 - 3. "<u>What</u> a waste; it should have been sold!"
 - Scornful
 - Scolding
 - 4. "<u>Why</u> bother her?"
 - Poor always with you
 - Do not bother her done good deed ...
 - Do not always have Me Have poor ...

- Prepare My body for burial
 - All she could do
 - Anoint My body
- Preached gospel will remember her deeds
- C. The <u>Plan</u> of Judas: Betray Him for Money (14:10-11)
 - 1. Judas <u>went</u> to the chief priests
 - 2. The chief priests were <u>willing</u> to pay Judas
 - 3. Judas <u>watched</u> for an opportune time
- III. Conclusion:
 - The <u>caution</u> against the love of money (I Timothy 6:10)
 - The <u>confidence</u> of Jesus as He faces the cross
 - The costliness of extravagant love

- 2. What are some of the results of the fear of people which we see in our world and in our own lives?
- 3. What are some examples of extravagant love which you have observed, participated or been the beneficiary?

 - Why should you be cautious about the love of money?
 - How can you develop confidence in the face of hard times?
