  - **Cause**: sin, iniquity, acted wickedly, rebelled, turning aside, not listened, unfaithful deeds, disobeyed, transgressed, not sought God's favor, not giving attention to God's truth
  - *Effect*: Open shame, driven them (scattered/dispersed), curse poured out on us, great calamity, become a reproach
- 3. <u>Supplication</u> (vv. 16-19)
  - a. In light of God's character ...
  - b. ... we ask
    - Set aside anger and wrath
    - See our desolation/hear and forgive
    - See Your city and people
