DEAR PARENTS

Proverbs 22:6 ESV

Train up a child in the way he should go; even when he is old he will not depart from it.

1. We train our children through instruction and Godly disciplines

Ephesians 6:4

Fathers, do not provoke your children to anger, but bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord.

Our children need to be brought up with

- Instruction of the lord
- Discipline of the Lord

Deuteronomy 6:6-9 ESV

And these words that I command you today shall be on your heart. 7 You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise. 8 You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. 9 You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.

The commands of God should be

- Taught to our children diligently
- Talked about often

Deuteronomy 4:9-10 ESV

"Only take care, and keep your soul diligently, lest you forget the things that your eyes have seen, and lest they depart from your heart all the days of your life. Make them known to your children and your children's children— 10 how on the day that you stood before the Lord your God at Horeb, the Lord said to me, 'Gather the people to me, that I may let them hear my words, so that they may learn to fear me all the days that they live on the earth, and that they may teach their children so.'

Exodus 10:1-2 ESV

Then the Lord said to Moses, "Go in to Pharaoh, for I have hardened his heart and the heart of his servants, that I may show these signs of mine among them, 2 and that you may <u>tell in the hearing of your son and of your grandson</u> how I have dealt harshly with the Egyptians and what signs I have done among them, that you may know that I am the Lord."

2. We train our children through discipline

Proverbs 13:24 ESV

Proverbs 22:15 ESV

- Preserve our children

3. We train our children through example
