**OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD**  
**CURBSIDE DROP-OFF PROCESS**

**As a ministry, we want to continue to bring the hope of the Gospel through shoebox gifts to children across the globe. Drop-off Locations are the first step in the journey of a shoebox. As we look forward to National Collection Week 2020, Nov. 16-23rd, the ministry of Operation Christmas Child is moving forward with as traditional a year as possible, yet some changes in our collection of shoeboxes are unique to 2020.**

All Drop-off Locations will be following the curbside model this year so that shoebox donors feel comfortable and safe dropping off their shoeboxes at any Drop-off Location across the country.

What does a “Curbside Drop-off” mean?

Each Drop-off Location will be provided with signage to facilitate a curbside experience. When donors arrive at the Drop-off Location, they will follow signs to the “Curbside Drop-off Location: Park Here” sign.

Donors will be able to stay in their car as a volunteer, wearing PPE, walks them through filling out a Drop-off Form (digital or paper).

Other volunteers will move shoeboxes from the car into the building.

Shoeboxes will be cartonized and stored inside the building as normal, until delivered to a Central Drop-off Location or loaded onto a trailer.
